

## **Outcomes from Prior Mobile Outreach Service Teams (M.O.S.T.)**

### **Workforce Initiatives**

Since its inception in 2006, Mobile Outreach Service Teams (M.O.S.T.) has demonstrated that its accelerated, employer-driven workforce model consistently produces exceptional outcomes. Across nearly 1,200 workers served in eight states, the program achieved a 97% training completion rate, a 95% job placement rate, and a 91% six-month employment retention rate. Historical program records from Florida, Mississippi, and New England, together with participant-level databases, demonstrate that these outcomes were achieved through successful recruitment, accelerated training, direct employer placement, and long-term workforce retention. The representative workforce initiatives summarized below illustrate M.O.S.T.'s proven ability to rapidly deploy workforce solutions that meet regional employer demand.

### **Overall Program Performance**

- Nearly 1,200 workers served across eight states.
- 97% training completion rate.
- 95% job placement rate.
- 91% six-month employment retention rate.
- Employer-driven training customized to specific workforce requirements.
- Rapid placement into high-demand occupations following successful completion.

### **Representative Workforce Initiatives**

#### **Florida**

- 167 participants enrolled; 164 completed training (98.2%).
- 141 participants placed into employment (86.0% of completers).
- Average starting wage approximately \$12.91/hour; wages ranged from \$8.00 to \$23.00/hour.
- 31 participating employers across Miami, Orlando, Tallahassee, and Tampa.
- Approximately \$15.5 million estimated economic impact.

#### **Mississippi**

- 109 participants enrolled; 108 completed training (99.1%).
- 108 participants placed into employment.
- Average starting wage approximately \$12.52/hour.
- Projects conducted in Biloxi and Grenada.

#### **New England**

- 372 participants enrolled; 340 completed training (91.4%).
- 247 participants placed into employment; 200 retained.
- Average starting wage approximately \$15.00/hour.

- Projects conducted in Portland and Biddeford, Maine; Worcester and Greenfield, Massachusetts; Nashua and Manchester, New Hampshire; Middlebury and Bennington, Vermont

### **Documented Participant Outcomes**

- 162 participants entered training.
- 145 completed training.
- 128 entered employment.
- 100% of placed participants completed employer on-the-job training.
- 118 completed the mentoring component.
- Documented promotions and wage increases following placement.
